GUIDELINES FOR VISITING TYNECASTLE PARK

Please observe the following rules, designed to keep everyone safe, when visiting Tynecastle Park.

Group bookings will only be allowed to a **maximum of six people from two households**, please ensure your booking complies with this as this is now enforced by the Scottish Government.

Do not visit if you feel unwell or you are living with anyone showing symptoms (high temperature, persistent cough, changes to taste and/or smell).

You will be thermo scanned on arrival and if you have a temperature of 37.8 degrees or above then you will be asked to leave the premises and return in ten minutes. If a second check does not return a lower temperature then you will not be permitted entry.

You must provide contact details for you and other guests in your booking. We will check these on arrival. You may be required to produce photographic ID to confirm identity.

To comply with government guidelines, we will keep your information securely for 28 days, at which point it will be destroyed.

Hand sanitising stations are available throughout. Please use these as instructed.

Tables will be placed 2 metres apart. During your visit please observe the 2 metre social distancing rules and do not mix with other tables.

Guests must stay seated when they are having a drink, table service will be provided and guests should only leave their seat if using the toilet facilities.

Guests must observe social distancing guidelines when using toilet facilities. The signage relating to this is clearly marked.

Face coverings must be worn in hospitality settings, apart from when seated at your table. In consultation with the relevant authorities we have been advised that face coverings must be worn when the match is being shown.
